2. Operational Area & Coverage

Tamas Society operates extensively across West Bengal, focusing on both urban slums and rural communities:

- **Kolkata District:** Kolkata Municipal Corporation Wards No. 82 & 88 (including Chetla Lock Gate Slum).
- **South 24 Parganas District:** 15 Villages in Kheyadaha Gram Panchayet - 2, Sonarpur Block.
- **Howrah District:** 6 Villages in Amta Block - 2.

3. Programmatic Highlights & Achievements (2025-2026)

Healthcare & Preventive Interventions

Tamas Society organizes multi-disciplinary general health check-up camps covering Blood Pressure, Blood Sugar, ECG, Hepatitis B vaccinations, Eye Testing, and Cataract assessments with free surgeries. Comprehensive curative and preventive care is provided completely free of cost to marginalized slum and rural residents.

Nutritious Meal Program

Our flagship nutrition initiative provides regular daily meals (breakfast, lunch, and dinner) to 120 underprivileged children (ages 4-14) at Chetla Lock Gate slum. Prepared in a centralized kitchen, hot meals are transported daily in hygienic steel containers, operating 365 days a year including Sundays and public holidays.

Education & Livelihood Skill Training

Educational programs encompass Pre-school (3-6 yrs), Non-Formal Education (6-14 yrs), Remedial Education, and Bridge Courses (14-18 yrs drop-outs). Complementing education, our Vocational Training & Livelihood Centers empower youth and women in Basic Computer Education, Tailoring & Stitching, English Proficiency, and Leather Craft.

4. Institutional Partners & Supporters
